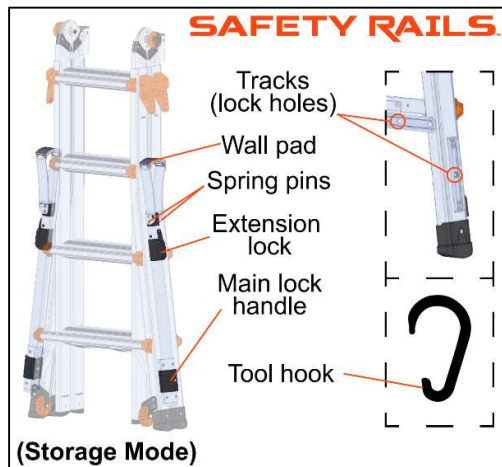
The Epic ladder is the **NEW** articulating ladder from Little Giant Ladders. This ladder includes the **extendable safety rails**. The safety rails can be placed vertically or horizontally on the ladder. When placed vertically in the walkthrough position, the rails extend above the top of the ladder, giving you a sturdy handhold. This feature is ideal when climbing to the roof of the house, because it gives you a stabilizing surface to move from ladder to roof with ease.



Additionally, the non-marring safety rails can be placed horizontally in the stand-off position, so you can set up your ladder around windows, spanning a distance of up to 7 feet. In its horizontal stand-off position, you can place hanging hooks on the rails, where you can hang items up to 15 lbs.



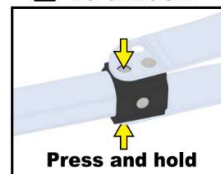

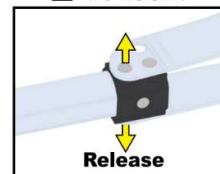
STANDOFF MODE:

1. Before setting ladder up, install arms to horizontal track, extending out sides of ladder (Fig. A).
2. Use extension locks to extend arms to desired width (Fig. B).
3. Rotate wall pads 90-degrees into use position (Fig. C).
4. Make sure spring pins and extension locks are fully locked before setting up ladder as described on ladder's labels (Fig. D).
